INSTALLATION

Adobe™ Lightroom™ is required to install and use these presets. They are easy to install. While there are several ways to install Develop Presets in Lightroom, Importing is the simplest. Here's how you do it:

- 1) Unzip the file you downloaded containing the presets.
- 2) Open Lightroom.
- 3) Switch to the the Develop [D] module and create a new folder in the presets (found on the left) called "STELLER" or whatever you want to call it.
- 4) Right-click on the new folder you just created and select "Import..."
- 5) Navigate to the unzipped folder called "STELLER Presets" and import them.

HOW TO USE THESE PRESETS

Due to the nature of the wide variety on individual shooting styles, camera types and camera settings, these presets will behave differently on different photos. The best way to utilize these presets is to use them as a STARTING POINT for your photography workflow and to develop your own post-processing style there-in.

- 1) Open Lightroom.
- 2) Select a photo in the in Lightroom's Develop [D] module
- 3) With the Photo selected, roll your cursor over the different presets showing on the left side of the screen. Do you see the cool preview on the top left? Awesome, huh?
- 4) Once you find one you like, click it.
- 5) The preset settings are applied to the selected photo.
- 6) Modify the settings on the right as necessary for the individual photo. This is an important step, because every photo session is different and requires your touch. The Steller Presets serve as a fantastic starting point to jump you into your very own lightning-fast image workflow.
- 7) Sync those settings with other similar photos to quickly batch an entire set.
- 8) Export the JPGs and you're done!
